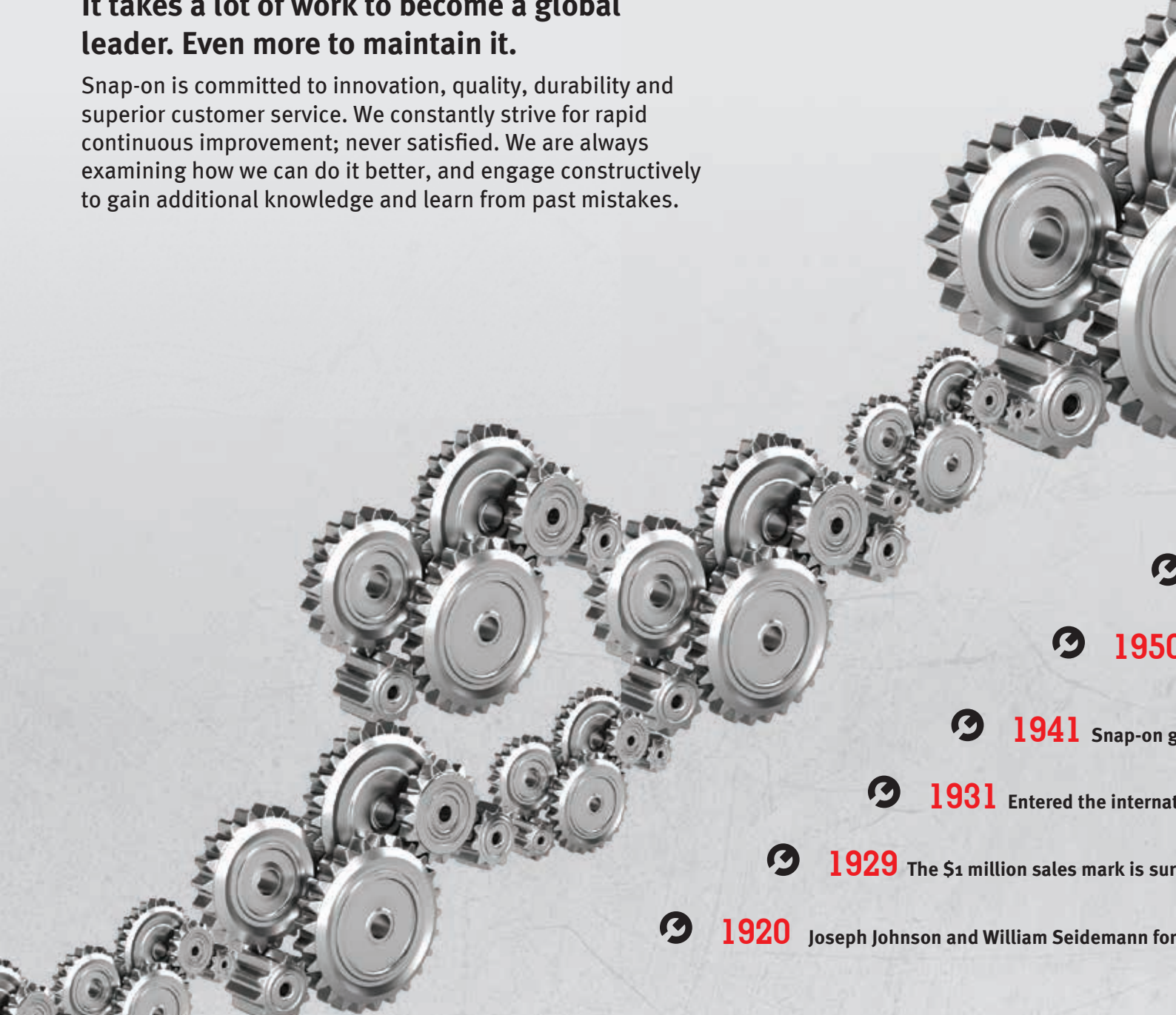

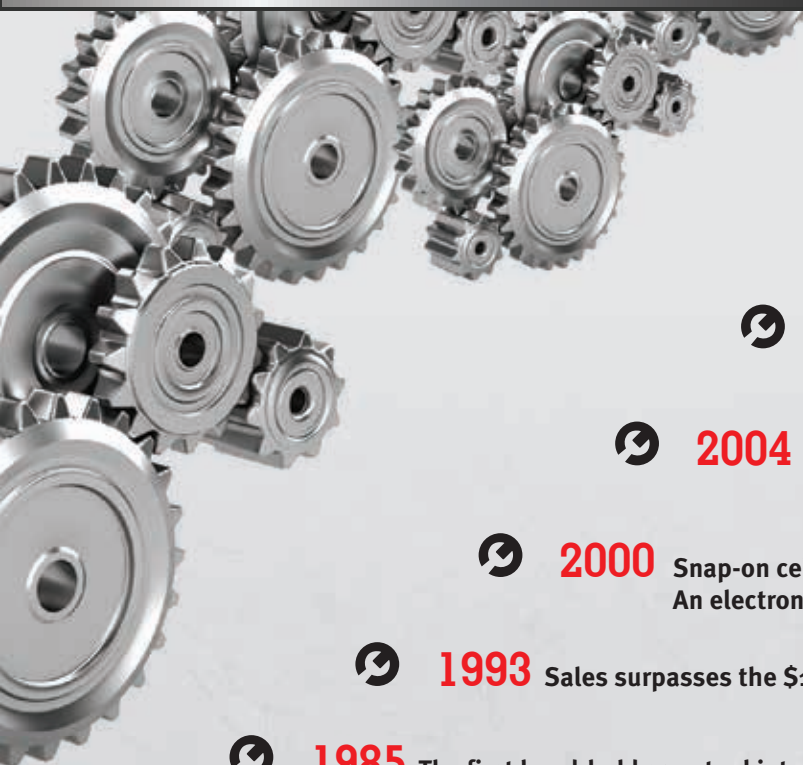

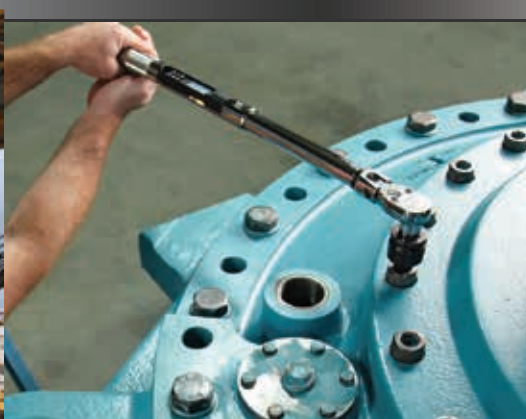
Snap-on first entered the international arena in 1931. Today, its products and services can be found in more than 130 countries around the world.

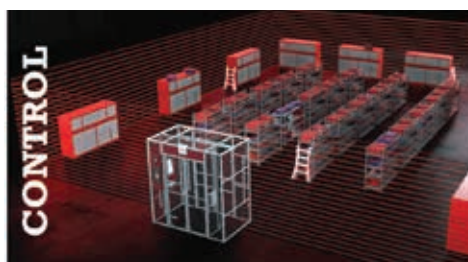

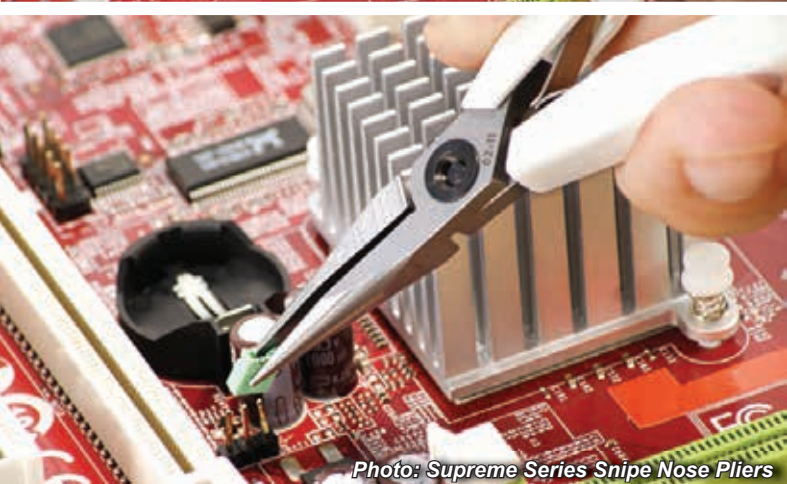

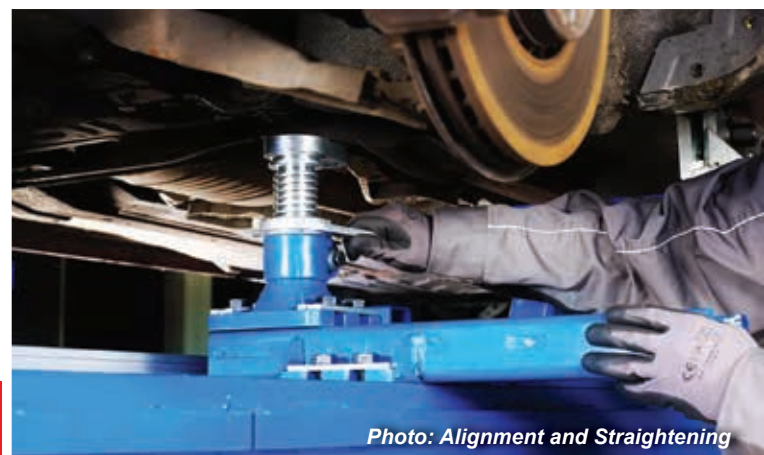
